This experiential AVP workshop begins the first day with inclusive community building, how prejudice operates in daily communication, and finding transforming power in everyone and every moment. The last day explores experimenting with relying on transforming power to guide our decisions and lives, experience the liberty of conscience, and then reflect on the whole and close.
